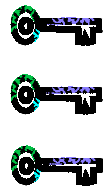

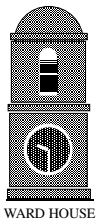

## **The Six Keys to Outstanding Shared**

*We “..... have to imbue our children with a love of reading – we get ourselves hot and bothered about the teaching of reading, about synthetic phonics ..... and we forget that none of it is much use unless children really want to read in the first place”.*

### **WORKSHOP BACKGROUND**

Given the current frenzy of interest and concern about the importance of retaining a reading culture in a televisual age, this very latest workshop of Alan Peat's Regional Series is both timely and transformational. 'Timely' because Alan puts down some markers to balance the "why children aren't reading" lobby– after all, as Alan says, children will read if they want to – and 'transformational' because participants will enjoy a life-enhancing experience (professionally speaking) in gaining unimaginable insights into reading per se as well as the process of encouraging children to develop a passion for reading.

### **WORKSHOP FOCUS**

If you are wanting professional development on reading that isn't just reliant on phonics and which enables a 'whole school' approach based on exciting pedagogy then ~Alan's workshop is the answer. Alan explores a host of practical ideas related to the 'Six Keys model' he has developed and he shares examples of texts to engage pupils which include strategies guaranteed to excite reluctant readers and a host of ideas designed to appeal to boys.

In addition Alan introduces his 'Visual Talk, Writing Targets' methodology and demonstrates how these can be used with wordless picture books as a new way to motivate early readers.

*Alan is the author of fifteen publications on a wide range of subjects. His literacy books have been best-sellers for both Nash Pollock Publishing and Questions Publishing. He also writes for the Times Education Supplement, Teaching Thinking magazine and a wide range of other journals. His practical ideas have now been used in 22 countries. Previously Alan has been an LEA Adviser with cross-phase responsibility for Literacy and Gifted & Talented provision. He has also been Head of the Museum & Gallery Education Service and Teaching & Learning Consultant for Blackburn LEA. Currently he is the Director of Creative Educational Press Ltd and runs the international independent education consultancy company 'Alan Peat Ltd' which specialises in creativity, literacy development, thinking skills, middle management training and gifted and talented provision. A Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts, Alan is also a member of the National Association of Writers in Education (N.A.W.E.).*

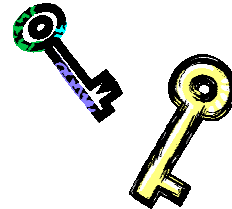

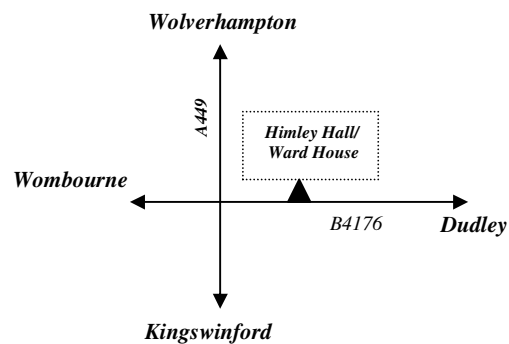
