"The 8 assessment foci (AFs) for writing describe the key elements of performance in this attainment target. They are linked to the National Curriculum programmes of study and the level descriptors and are designed to give a detailed, analytic view of pupils' attainment across all the key stages and in all types of writing."

Workshop One - Thursday 21 January 2010 (ref: 3737) – *Please note this will address Foci 5-8*

Aim: To 'unpick' AF 5-8 AND, for the first time, provide ALL participants with LEVELLED teaching strategies which will facilitate transition from level 1-2 / 2-3 / 3-4 and 4-5 thereby moving participants towards a WHOLE SCHOOL APPROACH to all the writing elements included in APP. This programme includes:

AF5	<i>Vary sentences for clarity, purpose and effect</i>
AF6	<i>Write with technical accuracy of syntax and punctuation in phrases, clauses and sentences</i>
AF7	<i>Select appropriate and effective vocabulary</i>
AF8	<i>Use correct spelling</i>



Workshop Two - Thursday 25 February 2010 (ref: 3741) – *unravels Foci 1-4*

Aim: To 'unpick' AF 1-4 AND, for the first time to provide ALL participants with LEVELLED teaching strategies which will facilitate transition from level 1-2 / 2-3 / 3-4 and 4-5 thereby moving participants towards a WHOLE SCHOOL APPROACH to all the writing elements included in APP. This programme includes:

AF1	<i>Write imaginative, interesting and thoughtful texts</i>
AF2	<i>Produce texts which are appropriate to task, reader and purpose</i>
AF3	<i>Organise and present whole texts effectively, sequencing and structuring information, ideas and events</i>
AF4	<i>Construct paragraphs and use cohesion within and between paragraphs</i>

Applications are of course welcome for either or both workshops.

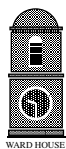
Fees: £315pp for two day programme --- £175pp for single workshop
